

How to Select a Wav File Player in Windows

Using Windows Sound Recorder

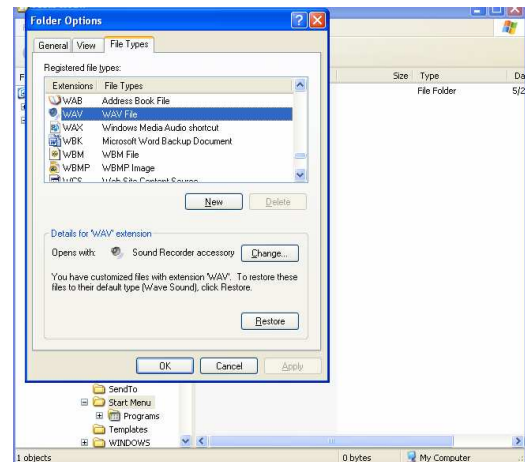
1. Open Windows Explorer by right clicking the on the **START** button and choosing **Explore**



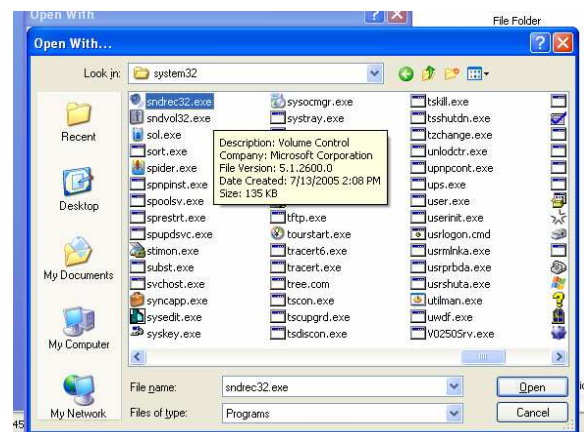
2. In Windows Explorer, choose **Tools, Folder Options**



3. Click the **File Types** tab and search for the entry for wav
4. Click the button labeled **Change**
5. Then select **'Sound Recorder Accessory'**.
6. If you find an entry for Sound Recorder Accessory, select it and go to step 9, otherwise continue with Step 7 as follows:
7. Click **Browse** and locate the following folder: **C:\Windows\System32**



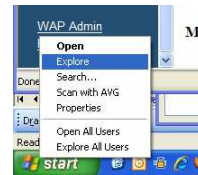
8. Search for the file **sndrec32.exe**
9. Click the Open button
10. Click OK to close the Folder Option box
11. Click Close to save changes.
12. Restart your computer



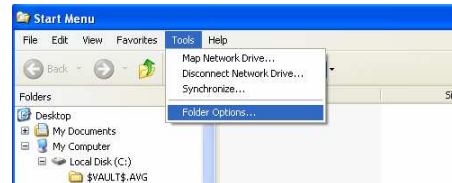
How to Select a Wav File Player in Windows

Using Windows Media Player

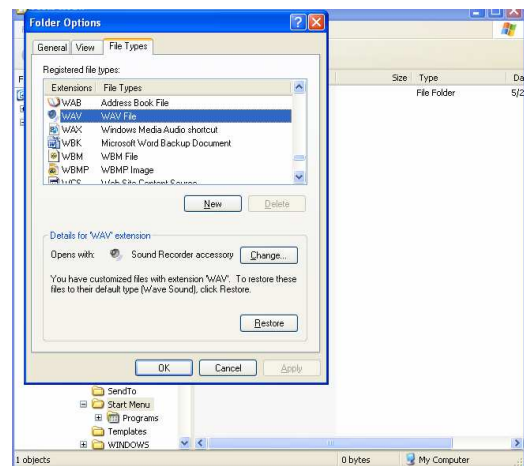
1. Open Windows Explorer by right clicking the on the **START** button and choosing **Explore**



2. In Windows Explorer, choose **Tools**, **Folder Options**



3. Click the **File Types** tab and search for the entry for wav
4. Click the button labeled **Change**
5. Then select **'Windows Media Player'**
6. Click **OK** to close the Folder Option box
7. Click **Close** to save changes.
8. Restart your computer



Setting File Associations in Windows Vista

1. Go to **Control Panel**
2. Choose **Default Programs**
3. Choose **Associate file type or protocol with a program**
4. Look for **'wav sound file'**
5. Click **Change Program**
6. Choose **Windows Media Player**
7. Click **OK**
